HOME INSULATION

As temperatures drop for winter, now is a good time to look critically at our homes and determine how well insulated they really are. Grants are available from SEAI (Sustainable Energy Authority of Ireland) to upgrade private residences – this can take the form of replacing windows and doors with double / triple glazing, insulating roof spaces or insulating walls. The latter can be undertaken by injecting cavity walls with polystyrene beads or foam, by cladding the outside walls with insulation or by insulating the walls on the inside. The last option does involve domestic disruption, as windowsills need to be made deeper and radiators moved, but the improved heat retention is immediate. The money spent on any or all of these measures will be recouped by having lower heating bills. More importantly, the use of (predominantly fossil) fuels will be reduced, which in turn will reduce carbon dioxide emissions.
